FIRE PIT (OPEN BURNING)

SUBMITALS

- Four (4) sets of Plat of Survey including locations of the fire pit, dimensions, and distance to property lines with all required property setbacks
- Four (4) sets of complete plans, drawn to scale, showing type of material fire pit is to be made of and if any gas piping is to be installed.
- Complete permit application/four (4) sets of drawings.
- A fire pit must **NOT** be located in any utility or drainage easement
- The fire must be attended at all times.
- The fire must be contained within a devise intended for this purpose, e.g. commercial fire pit, masonry pit.
- Sawn firewood is the only material allowed, No construction debris or landscape waste.
- The fire pit must be 25 feet away from a structure per 2006 International Fire Code Section 307.4.2.
- Under the provisions of the International Fire Code, adopted by DuPage County, the Village of Itasca and the Fire District: The fire Official has the right to determine and thereby prohibit the fire based on a determination:
 - That it is offensive of objectionable because of smoke or odor emissions
 - Atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fire hazardous, e.g. dry conditions caused by no rain
