ORDINANCE NO. 89-2

**ORDINANCE OF THE ITASCA FIRE PROTECTION
DISTRICT NO. 1 ESTABLISHING A FIRE MUTUAL AID RESPONSE**

WHEREAS, all parties have been participating in the Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS) to provide for communication of said protection of life and property from an emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, an ad hoc committee has revised the existing MABAS contract to address the dynamics of change that have impacted upon the fire service since the original contract; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Illinois, 1970, Article VII, Section 10, authorizes units of local government to contract and otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Revised Statutes, 1985, Chapter 127, Section 741 et seq., entitled the "Intergovernmental Cooperation Act", provides that any power or powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a unit of local government may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any unit of local government; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have determined that it is in their best interests to enter into this Agreement to secure to each the benefits of mutual aid in fire protection, firefighting, and the protection of life and property from an emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said organization is to establish procedures to be followed in an emergency situation that threatens or causes loss of life and property and exceeds the physical and organizational capabilities of a single unit of local government; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Itasca Fire Protection District No. 1 after due investigation have determined that membership in said organization will benefit the residents of said Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Itasca Fire Protection District No. 1, DuPage County, Illinois that the President and the Secretary of this District be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for participation in the Mutual Aid Box Alarm System, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and being made a part hereof.




WHEREAS, each community desires to supplement said agreement to provide automatic fire mutual aid to specific areas within both communities, as outlined on the attached agreement; and

WHEREAS, said agreement is a direct benefit to the Itasca Fire Protection District No. 1 and its residents by improving upon the District's fire service capabilities.







AUTOMATIC FIRE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE WOOD DALE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT,
ILLINOIS AND THE ITASCA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, ILLINOIS.

In accordance with Chapter 24, Section 11-6-1 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, which empowers Municipalities and Fire Protection Districts to enter into "Mutual Aid Agreements", and in accordance with the MABAS agreement entered into by the Wood Dale Fire Protection District and the Itasca Fire Protection District in 1973, renewed in 1989, the Wood Dale Fire Protection District and the Itasca Fire Protection District agree to provide automatic aid to each other on structural fire alarms, explosions, vehicle fires inside of a structure, possible structure fire or confirmed structure fire:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Equipment responding on an automatic response to the other community shall have a minimum of two (2) fire department personnel.
2. Only one (1) unit from the fire department providing aid shall be required to respond at any one time. In the event that the unit due is unavailable (i.e., out of service, committed to another call), no back-up unit from another station shall be required to respond.
3. At all times, the district within which the emergency exists will be in charge and responsible for the operations at the emergency scene. If an automatic aid unit is first on the scene, the company officer shall exercise his/her discretion as to the appropriate action to be taken. Upon the arrival of a company officer from the community having jurisdiction, command of the emergency scene shall be transferred in a smooth and efficient manner to the fire department whose district in which the emergency exists.
4. Each district shall be responsible for providing a communications system which will allow apparatus to apparatus communications; while enroute and while on the scene.
5. Each district agrees to provide and participate in monthly CO-OP training between the two (2) fire protection districts.
6. Each district agrees that the general provisions of the "MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT" apply to this agreement, except as modified by this agreement.
7. Each district agrees to waive all claims against the other party for compensation for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of performance in conjunction with this agreement. General liability insurance, personal injury insurance, and property/vehicle insurance shall be the responsibility of each individual district.

RESPONSE AREA

- I. The Wood Dale Fire Protection District agrees to provide the Itasca Fire Protection District; subject to the provisions of paragraph two (2) of the general conditions of this agreement:
 - A. One (1) engine company to the following area:
 1. All response areas within the boundaries of the Itasca Fire Protection District.
- II. The Itasca Fire Protection District agrees to provide the Wood Dale Fire Protection District; subject to the provisions of paragraph two (2) of the general conditions of this agreement:
 - A. One (1) engine company to the following area:
 1. Response area North of the railroad tracks.
 - B. One (1) truck company to the following area:
 1. Response area South of the railroad tracks.

Minor modifications to the above response area (s), as well as the vehicles assigned, may be made without further modification to this agreement. However, said modifications must be mutually agreed upon, by the two (2) respective Fire Chiefs.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT


Either the Wood Dale Fire Protection District or the Itasca Fire Protection District may terminate this agreement by notifying the Fire Chief of the other Fire Protection District, in writing, sixty (60) days from the date of written notice.


TERM OF AGREEMENT


This agreement shall be effective as of the 15th day of March, 1994 and shall continue in full force until terminated by either party.
