Unincorporated Water Connection Permit

- Contact DuPage County Health Department to determine whether to seal the well or convert it into a supplemental well. For more information please review: [Water | DuPage County Health, IL](#)

After determining to seal the well or convert it to a supplemental well complete the following:

- **For Sealing a Well:** Contact a licensed contractor to apply for a permit to properly seal the well. Choose a licensed contractor that is familiar with DuPage County Health Department's requirements. If you have additional questions, call 630-682-7400 and ask to speak with the area inspector for Itasca.

- **For Supplemental process:** You/your contractor can apply online, and the area inspector will contact the homeowner for next steps. Call 630-682-7400 and ask to speak with the area inspector for Itasca.

Note: The Village of Itasca **needs** to see County documentation on well (capped or supplemental *which means irrigation only, with a RPZ and no connection into the home*)

Requirements:

1. Plat of Survey
 - Showing the proposed water service connection location
 - The dimensions between water and sewer lines (when applicable)

Engineering will need to be approved the Plat of Survey before the permit is released. The design should meet the Development Standards.

- You/ your contractor will apply for a “**Residential Accessory Structure Permit.**”

- Apply for a “Right-of-way” (Row) Permit

- *Posting of a bond will be required.*
- *Bloomingdale Township will need the details regarding your water line connection due to cutting into the road.*
- Provide proof of being connected to the Village of Itasca water supply.
 - Water service connection requires a fixture count in your home to the correct water service that is needed.

Inspection required:

- The Village will need a “Rough plumbing (interior and exterior)”
- Final inspection is required and can be scheduled by calling the Village of Itasca Community Development team at: 630-773-5568
