According to Illinois law, the petitioner (Haymarket) has a right to have its proposal considered by Itasca’s Plan Commission and the Village Board. Haymarket’s application is scheduled to be considered at the September 18th Plan Commission meeting, as long as Haymarket submits all required documentation by the review deadline.

I encourage each and every interested resident to attend the Plan Commission meeting, so that their comments become part of the public record. The Plan Commission may only consider comments documented during the official public hearing when it makes a recommendation to the Village Board.

**OPEN LETTER TO ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS
REPRESENTING THE CITIZENS OF ITASCA, ILLINOIS**

July 29, 2019

To all elected representatives, local officials, and other concerned parties representing the residents and taxpayers of Itasca, Illinois:

It has come to our attention that an organization known as McDermott Center, d/b/a Haymarket Center (and herein referred to as "Haymarket"), has announced its intent to purchase the parcel of land at 860 W Irving Park Road in Itasca, currently a Holiday Inn Hotel and Conference Center, with plans to convert it into a 200-bed inpatient addiction treatment facility.

We too ask that all governing bodies with authority over the matter reject this facility, on the grounds that:

- Itasca is ill-suited to accommodate the treatment center from an emergency services standpoint,
- The location is unacceptably close to public facilities geared towards children, such as our public library and waterpark, and youth-focused businesses,
- The loss of property tax revenue, hotel/entertainment tax revenue, and other collateral sales tax revenues associated with normal hotel and convention operations will have a detrimental effect on Village finances, and,
- The construction of the facility will result in a negative impact on property values for all residents and business owners in proximity to the location.

We, as residents, taxpayers, and concerned business owners want to make clear that we do not oppose the *purpose* of the facility. We recognize the importance of substance abuse treatment services, and understand the current state of the opioid epidemic in Chicago, the suburbs, and nationwide. That said, we believe Itasca is an illogical choice for this type of treatment facility based on the size and population of our community.

Itasca is a community of approximately 8,000 residents. The proposed 200-bed facility would represent, at full capacity, roughly 2.5% of our overall population. The stated purpose of the facility is to treat substance abuse, with a focus on opioid addiction. For reference, the Village of Itasca had a total of three (3) arrests for controlled substances in 2018 and zero (0) in 2017.¹

While advocates for this facility and its programs will argue that those in the facility are seeking treatment and therefore are not a risk to the community, it is worth noting that not all patients of the facility are there involuntarily, and are permitted to come and go as they wish.² There are a number of youth- and public-focused facilities in the immediate vicinity:

- Itasca Village Hall, 1000ft
- Itasca Public Library, 1600ft
- Itasca Waterpark, 1500ft
- Noles Nation Training Academy, 1900ft
- Spring Brook Nature Center, 2100ft
- Itasca School District Administration, 3100ft
- Usher Park, 3800ft
- Itasca Park District, 4400ft
- Raymond Benson Primary School, 4600ft
- FE Peacock Middle School, 4700ft
- Happy Acres Park, 3600ft
- Elmer H Franzen Intermediate School, 3100ft
- Gym Stars Gymnastics, 830ft
- Music & Arts, 900ft

Additionally, within a 2000ft radius of the proposed location, there are three (3) video gaming/gambling parlors and a full-service liquor store. There are several more bars and gambling establishments within a 1-mile radius as well.

It is our contention that the construction of this facility will lead to an increase in drug-related crimes in the immediate area, thus straining our limited police resources.

We also have concerns about the ability of the Village's current emergency response infrastructure to handle the increase in calls for service that would be associated with the type of facility in question.

According to data released by the City of Chicago, there were 863 emergency responses to Haymarket's existing location at 932 W Washington Street in Chicago (and adjacent connected facilities). With only one available ambulance, neighboring communities with which we have mutual aid agreements will need to cover for our fire department, resulting in longer response times and possible navigation issues with crews being less familiar with the area. Depending on the terms of mutual aid agreements, these responses may also cost taxpayers

additional money or result in varying fees being charged to residents who need emergency services.

Just last year, Itasca Fire Protection District taxpayers approved a referendum to increase taxes to fund the District's operations. At the time, the increase was described as a way to allow the District to "keep what we have"³, and did not anticipate a need for the type of significant expansion required by this facility.

We believe that the loss of tax revenue (approximately \$250,000 annually)⁴ resulting from the conversion of the facility and transfer to a non-profit organization will negatively impact the finances of the Village of Itasca and other taxing bodies, and will force either a tax increase, or a reduction of services for those already in the community. At the top of our list of tax concerns is the fact that the losses represent a hit of approximately \$50,000 against the budgets of both our High School and Elementary School Districts.

Finally, we contend that the stigma associated with such a facility will result in drastic reductions in property values in the immediate vicinity, which by extension also impacts the finances of the Village and other taxing bodies. Studies show negative impacts of up to 17% on home values in the immediate area of these facilities.⁵

In conclusion, we ask you, our political representatives, local officials, and other decision-makers to take these concerns into consideration, and ultimately, to reject the construction of the Haymarket facility in the Village of Itasca. It is our contention that a failure to stand up for our Village in the face of pressure from outside entities, higher governing bodies, and less-informed members of the public would constitute a dereliction of your duty to represent those who elected you and who fund your public positions through taxes.

Dear Mr. Mayor,

I am writing to you to voice my concerns with the proposed Haymarket center in Itasca. Although addiction treatment is important, I believe the close proximity to our downtown area, parks and schools is not something that the village should allow; and it doesn't fit the vision of what we are trying to make Itasca. Additionally, our small town's police and EMS/Rescue services will be overburdened by the additional responses they will have to make to the facility. This will result in increased costs to the village and ultimately the residents. This center belongs in a much larger city that has more EMS/Police resources and perhaps in an established medical district. Additionally, losing any hotel tax revenue (of which the city currently collects \$1.2 million a year) would not be advantageous for the village. If the Holiday Inn is planning to leave regardless of the outcome, its real estate is located near one of our industrial parks, which if redeveloped could increase our tax base and prosperity in Itasca. Please join myself and our neighbors in opposition to the Haymarket project.

Dear Mayor Pruyn and Village Trustees,

I am writing to express my grave concerns regarding the Haymarket Itasca proposal.

I believe excellent concerns have already been expressed about the potential negative impact this would have on our town's revenue and the strain it will place on our police and fire departments. What I believe needs to be communicated by Itasca residents is the concern regarding the destructive impact this will have on property values in the community, how this will irrevocably alter the public image of our town, and the detrimental effect this will have on public safety.

My wife and I bought our home in Itasca a little more than a year ago. We were attracted to Itasca because of its quiet, family focused nature. My grandparents raised my mother and aunts and uncle in Itasca and continue live here. As a child I spent a considerable amount of time coming out to Itasca and visiting my grandparents. I remember always feeling safe — being able to play outside and walk with my cousins to the park at Franzen without any concern for our safety. I always held high regard for this town, and becoming a resident was a proud and happy moment for me.

I have had first hand experience with the impact of having a clinic like this, having worked in an area that was blocks away from a similar clinic in an upscale neighborhood of Chicago. The summation of the impact was that the entire area was permanently scarred by the facility. There was a constant police presence necessary to maintain order and protect regular people from being harassed and attacked. The local businesses had to harden themselves against theft and vandalism; they were, as a result, incredibly unwelcoming places and often were stages for further negative interactions with the clinic patients. The neighborhood was also a prime area for drug dealers to target, knowing they had easy access to vulnerable and amenable potential clientele. As an able bodied, single, adult male, I often found myself feeling defensive and overly cautious in the area. As a now husband and father, I would never feel comfortable bringing my family to an area like that.

Opening a clinic like the one proposed will destroy the faith that I, and I would imagine every other parent in the community, have that this is a town that values safety, especially the safety of children. While I sympathize with the patients, I absolutely will not tolerate that type of presence in my town. I want to raise a family in a safe community. I want to be able to move freely about my town and not have to be on constant alert. I want my wife to feel secure taking our son for a walk through our neighborhood. I want to be able to bring my child to the park and not have to worry about protecting him from derelicts or finding needles and other paraphernalia littered about. I do not want my child exposed to that kind of lifestyle.

A facility like this does not belong anywhere near a residential area, or schools, or parks, or anywhere else families frequent.

It is my hope and expectation that this proposal will never be approved, and that this clinic will not be permitted to open and ultimately destroy our community.

Jeff,

Thanks for speaking at the Lions meeting last night. Obviously, the Haymarket situation is overshadowing everything else in town, and this is to be expected. As the mayor, you can't really publicly "take a side" on it, and that's the right way to go about it.

If I may give you my two cents on it ... while I have full empathy and sympathy for people who need help (although let's be honest ... people make choices to do drugs, it really shouldn't fall on others), our little town is not an ideal location for this. Do some research on Haymarket in Chicago - it's awful. People overdosing in there, because their friends or family bring them drugs and/or alcohol. Numerous 911 calls, etc. I cannot imagine a scenario in which people from anywhere can just get off the train in Itasca and walk to where the Holiday Inn is, and start bringing drugs and who knows what else, into our community. Places like Haymarket should be out in the country, isolated and far away from where people can get to them, etc.

One other concern I have - Diane Pappas - no disrespect to you if she is a friend of yours, but the opinion of most people in town, is that she is a problem. People think that she is a typical extreme far-left Democrat, who wants to globalize Itasca and make it over-diverse, etc. She made a statement about it, but everyone thinks it's a smokescreen - the minute Haymarket offers a grant, she's jump on it. The fact is, Itasca really doesn't need to change what it is and what it has always been, for 150 years. It is as close to Mayberry as you can get in this day and age and it really needs to stay that way. I have friends who work in, or have family who work in the industrial park behind the Holiday Inn, and their business owners have told them they are watching this closely and if Haymarket comes in, they all will be looking to leave. That's the last thing we need to have happen.

Below is my letter I have written and shared with some dupage county public officials and state representatives. I would also like to share it with you so that you may pass it along to the village

I am a very concerned citizen of Itasca as I research and understand the impact the proposed Haymarket DuPage center in Itasca will have on our small town. Please let me state that I am not against a center or the people who need help, I full understand the need, however the location currently being proposed is the complete wrong fit for MANY reasons.

- * Itasca is one of the smallest towns in DuPage county with limited resources, the facility proposed will be one of the largest.
- * Itasca will loose \$250,000 annual in sales tax revenue which will heavily impact our schools and emergency services. Our schools are already in need, we have playgrounds that need updating, our teachers are one of the lowest paid in the area and our schools are in need of expansion. However we don't have the funds to do these things, taking money away from our schools will just impact our kids too much.
- * Itasca recently passed a referendum to help the fire department with their finances.
- * Itasca shares a police chief with Wood Dale
- * Adding a 200 bed facility will require extra medical and police attention. This is based on FOIA'd information from the Haymarket location in Chicago. Haymarket Chicago called 911 for service 863 times in 1 year. That breaks down to more than 2 calls per day. Itasca only has 1 ambulance.
- * Haymarket will have a mother/child area. Therefore if a mother is in treatment and her child(ren) are living with her, they will attend our schools, rightfully so. However, this is an added expense to educate children that are not part of the tax paying population. It costs approx. \$15,000 annually to educate a child (*information from Lake Park High School)
- * This location is within a very short walk of many public, children related business and facilities. Pool, library, Gym Stars, music lessons, hobby shop, nature center, nature walks, ect. A center that is an alternative to jail, that is not locked down and people can leave whenever they want should not be close to locations we send our kids.

I can see how this location is enticing, but have you considered the impact you will have on Itasca, our families and children. Not only Itasca, but have you considered this location in relation to the people you will be serving. This location is not near any essential resources for patients to help get them on track (grocery, public transportation) the closest venues are gambling, bars & liquor stores, which I would say are not good for those going to rehab.

This center will have life long impact on all who live in this village! A one time or opportunity to "apply" for grants won't fill the holes this center will put in Itasca.

Jeff,

Nice job in bringing up significant and important points to the Dailey Herald regarding the possible impact on the Haymarket facility in Itasca. It is extremely important to get the police/fire/ambulance data either from Haymarket or the City of Chicago. If Haymarket refuses to give such information, focus on that fact as a lack of cooperation on their part. If the data from them vs. City of Chicago differs significantly, question that aspect.

As a counselor, it is very hard for me to say I am against a treatment facility as they are very much needed. But, I am against this location and Haymarket. I have referred hundreds, literally, of people there for treatment. They take serve the population that no one else will serve. But, they have always had significant training and staffing issues. I encourage you to continue to focus on concrete facts and do not get engaged in the emotional stigma of drug addiction that will be thrust upon anyone who opposes this program being located in Itasca.

There are very important questions to ask regarding the facility, that you may have already thought of:

How will the clients get to the treatment center? This is not a proper location for addicts as they often have no access to transportation. The less accessible a program, the less likely any person will stay in the program. For the program and the addicts success, it's important to be located somewhere close to public transportation.

What are the staffing levels and can the town be guaranteed proper staffing?
What is the training of the staff and what are the salary levels of the jobs that will be created? Are we going to have the same issue as other places where minimum wage staff are bused in from other locals?
Education and licensure are important indication of a program's viability.

Will they have their own EMTs on staff for each shift? Will they provide their own Narcan and how much will they have on hand at a time? My unscientific guess is there will be one police/EMT/fire call per day fro this facility. It's the nature of such programs and why they should be in an area that can handle their calls. It's irresponsible for Haymarket to put such a program in an area that cannot provide the right level of service. They are doing a disservice to their clientele to do otherwise.

What is their public aid/no insurance/free beds vs. insurance clients numbers? My experience with Haymarket in Chicago was that it was nearly all state funded, no pay clientele.

Where is Haymarket getting all of this money? Do they have an endowment that will cover the building maintenance when state funding for this program dries up? What have they done with their properties in Chicago? How will they handle another spell of the state refusing to pay bills? It's going to happen and we have to plan for the future. How do we prevent this property from being abandoned in 10-20 years?

This money would be much better used to improve their training and staffing in the programs they already have, IMHO. Ask what their recidivism rate is and how their program functions. There are other programs in DuPage county or very close. This seems to be a grandstand issue for politicians that will just disappear in a few years. They aren't building good programs, they are throwing money into the wind. They aren't building safe communities, they are ignoring the needs of the state.

In the end, there is the reality of the addicts themselves. It doesn't matter if the addict is my neighbor or not. The addict's brain is fixated on a hit and literally changes. No matter the education or income level of the addict, the addict will do anything to get a fix. I foresee a lot of cars broken into at the Metra station, library, pool as the addicts walk to the treatment center. To ignore the reality of being an addict is foolish. Just as foolish as the shame and stigma that prevents people from getting help. Breaking the stigma does not mean ignoring the reality.

Hi Shannon,

I am writing to you as a concerned citizen of Itasca in hopes you will pass along my email to the planning commission.

I am in total opposition to the Haymarket drug treatment facility that is being proposed in the Holiday Inn space. Our small community of 8,000+ people cannot take on the financial responsibility of an establishment like this. The 4th smallest community in DuPage County is not equipped to handle a 200 bed drug treatment facility. Itasca is also not centrally located in DuPage County, and is near many children-centric establishments, like GymStars, the Itasca Library and the Itasca Waterpark.

We cannot lose the \$250,000 of tax revenue per year that would be forever lost in allowing a non-profit to take over that space. Our schools and other village entities desperately need the revenue and will suffer without these funds. Itasca residents also may be forced to foot the bill for these increased services, that will largely be used by non-residents.

We FOIAed Haymarket Chicago's 911 calls in 2018 and found that there were over 800 911 calls placed. We have one ambulance in town. Our emergency response systems cannot handle the amount of calls that would result from a treatment center like this. We definitely would have to invest in another ambulance and more emergency response workers, more cost to a small community that doesn't have the means to support this.

I urge you to listen to myself and other concerned citizens of Itasca that we DO NOT support Haymarket's drug treatment facility at the Holiday Inn location.

> I'm writing to urge you not to accept any kind of deal for lost hotel taxes or even property taxes. I think those issues are valid concerns but, for me, the primary issue is the risk to public safety posed by that the lack of resources for our Fire Department to handle the increased emergency calls that Haymarket will generate.

> I cannot believe a private ambulance service will be able to handle the high risk types of calls we should expect, based on 911 records for the Chicago location. Even Haymarket admitted they can only be used for non-emergencies. Incidentally, we are, based on Haymarket's comments to leaders of the No Itasca Haymarket group, to expect to have a similar number of treatment beds in Itasca as are located in Chicago. That means a greater portion of our 200 bed facility (about 3/4) will be treatment in nature vs. the approx 1/2 of the 400 beds in Chicago. For me, that means we can expect a similar call volume (nearly 900 per year) even though our overall headcount may be smaller. That is, on average, just over 2 calls per day in addition to our current needs.

> No matter the short term funding offered it will not fill the gap in emergency services funding in the long term.

> I read Haymarket's most recent letter of appeal and see the conspicuous use of the phrase reasonable accommodation and the mention of financial damages due to being delayed. I understand they are telling you they will sue the Village for discrimination using the ADA, FHAA, and Rehabilitation Act to force zoning and then also ask for financial damages if you don't rush the process. I have read Maxxam Partners v. Kane County. I understand Haymarket to be following that basic model BUT a legal defense to the accusation of discrimination should be the valid risk to public safety, including even to the potential patients and residents of Haymarket. If more than one life threatening emergency occurs at a time, they will also be at risk of a slower response time to assist Haymarket.

> Our first responders would be sorely taxed trying to keep up with the demands a facility of this size and nature would generate. Our residents who would be paying for all those 911 calls, would be receiving the short end of the stick when First responders are attending to Haymarket. Based on the numbers of 911 calls reported and many others that are not, at the smaller facility situated in Chicago, Itasca's facility would be so much bigger that it's unimaginable how those calls would increase for Itasca.

> This facility would be located extremely close to child centric, public sections of Itasca. The nature of the facility is such that it attracts the criminal element into the community. Anyone saying differently has not researched the data that's out there or met someone who has first hand experience with these elements.

> Itasca's best interest is not being considered and neither is the best interest of Haymarket patients.

> If they want a central location then Itasca is not centered in DuPage but I think they know this.

> I fear that what is being done is gearing up to transfer some or all of the patients to the Itasca location from Chicago and that Itasca would be considered not just for DuPage but the hub for most counties around DuPage, Cook, Will, Kane, etc.

> They have to know that a small town like Itasca will be destroyed if this happens and they just don't care enough. Haymarket can and should keep looking for a town that can sustain and afford all the economic and social, negative impacts that facilities like this one generate. They need to be situated somewhere far away from neighborhoods, somewhere like industrial areas.

> I hope the Itasca Board of Trustees sees the dangers in allowing Haymarket to settle in Itasca and votes No to their proposal.

Good afternoon,

I hope I am contacting the proper person for my questions. If not, please let me know and I can redirect my email or feel free to forward it for me if that is easier. I have two areas I have questions about related to the Haymarket proposal and the public hearing.

First, having read the economic impact statement provided by Haymarket and being concerned it was not especially thorough in addressing resident concerns (for example, loss of tax revenue but especially as it pertains to the use of emergency services) I was wondering if the village is able to contract for its own economic impact statement or provide for staff to research and present a response in areas where the village may not agree with Haymarket's characterization? At the meeting hosted by Diane Pappas I believe I heard you reference a staff report that would be prepared for the zoning committee's use, and wondered if I understood what that meant.

I am asking to help alleviate the concern many residents have that the village will only have Haymarket's plan as their information source, presented without critique or validation. Some residents view the public hearing as a time when the community is tasked with the necessity of countering Haymarket's claims and believe that if a resident doesn't speak to a particular point that the zoning board would have no choice but to accept Haymarket at their word on that item even if their information was not quite accurate or complete. I'm not sure what you can discuss ahead of time, but if you are at all able to provide clarification that I could share with other residents [by way of quoting from your emailed response in the facebook group] I would be grateful. If you prefer to remain silent, I also understand.

Second, I was wondering how the public hearing portion will be structured. I plan to speak and wanted to be prepared ahead of time with a few pieces of info. Do you expect a time limit to be imposed on each speaker? If so, if we would like to submit more information than can be spoken aloud at the meeting, can we also submit written testimony with additional items we did not read aloud? Can we bring a visual aid (like a poster board with a graph or map illustrating a point) and if so, would a regular page sized item be acceptable to submit as part of the record? For residents who cannot attend, can they submit written testimony and if so, must it still be read aloud by a representative in order to be included in the record or can their statement be submitted on paper?

I realize you may not have decided upon all these items yet, so if you can answer anything that's great, and if not, I don't want to burden you with needing to write back to me at some future date. I would instead ask that you clarify these items for the village sometime prior to the public hearing.


