If You Are a Victim of Identity Theft:

1. Report the incident to the police.
 - a. If you know the jurisdiction where your identity was stolen, that is where you should report the theft.
 - b. Insist on a police report number.
2. Report all lost or stolen credit cards and checks to the appropriate bank immediately.
3. Contact the Federal Trade Commission at (877) 438-4338 and log the complaint.
4. Contact the Social Security Administration's Fraud Hotline at (800) 269-0271.
5. Contact the fraud departments of the three major credit reporting agencies listed below.
 - a. Be sure to have a "Fraud/Victim Impact", statement placed in your credit file asking creditors to call you prior to opening any new accounts.
